Eligibility Criterion

- Students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks in the aggregate of the 'best five' marks obtained in the subjects including Bengali/Hindi & English or 50% marks in the subject or related subject are eligible to apply for admission in the Honours Course. The marks obtained in Environmental Studies will not be considered for calculating the aggregate of marks obtained.
- For General Course students have to pass H.S or equivalent examination.
- The candidates should have passed H.S examination or equivalent from any board or council enlisted by Vidyasagar University within last three years(2017,2018,2019). A relaxation of years may be given to those candidates who have special permission from Vidyasagar University.
- Candidates who have already filled form for examination under CBCS can not apply for fresh admission.

Application Process

- The admission will be done through an Online Merit Based System.
- Online Application Forms for admission will be available from Moyna College website – www.moynacollege.ac.in from 30.05.2019 to 10.06.2019 till 12 p.m. (Midnight)
- Application fee of Rs. 130/- (Rupees one hundred and thirty) only per subject applied for has to be paid online through Payment Gateway Mode or offline through bank.
- Applicants are directed to fill up every field of the application form carefully. Admission is liable to be cancelled at the time of verification of documents for any incorrect entry.

Selection Procedure

- Merit list for admission will be based on marks obtained (best five) in the subjects including two language subjects in the H. S. Examination conducted by WBCHSE and in case of other Boards the candidate must have passed in 5 (Five) recognized subjects including at least one language subject in the qualifying examination.
- Admission will be offered Online for the candidates whose names will be published in a particular E-Counseling List within the period specified for them. Admission must be taken within the specified period on payment of the requisite fees online or through Tamluk Ghatal Central Cooperative Bank, Moyna Branch .Some fees are paid later after verification.
- After preparation of E-Counseling List in the system an SMS will be sent to the mobile number of the candidate registered at the time of submission of the application for admission. However, the candidates should follow the website regularly and even if the SMS is not received by the candidate, admission may be taken online paying the requisite fees.
- Further E-Counseling Lists will be published as per seat availability.
- All admissions are subject to verification. Admission will be cancelled if documents are found not in conformity with the information provided in the forms submitted online.
